Aliso Springs Property Owners Association, Inc. Board Resolution #3 Subject: New Water Hookups

WHEREAS, Aliso Springs Property Owners Association, Inc. (ASPOA) owns and operates a domestic water system which provides potable water service to ASPOA members in an unincorporated area in Santa Cruz County, Arizona; and,

WHEREAS, from time to time members wish to connect to the ASPOA Water System to serve potable water to their new residence; and,

WHEREAS, ASPOA wishes to control the location of each water connection to the water main and the type of hardware used for that connection; and,

WHEREAS, ASPOA wishes to own the water meter to monitor consumption;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of ASPOA, as follows:

- 1. During the planning process the new homeowner will request a water system hook-up and will pay all association fees (regular assessments and special assessments) at or before that time.
- 2. ASPOA will own the new water meter and will bill the new homeowner for the installation.
- 3. New homeowners are responsible for all the plumbing from the meter to their new house.
- 4. New homeowners will be billed quarterly for their water consumption at current rates which may change from time to time.
